

## ENROLMENTS:

We are keen to establish lasting relationships with our patients and encourage enrolment to help facilitate this.

Enrolment is relatively simple. Visit us at our new premises at 2 Oliver Street with these items and we'll do the rest:

- a completed Enrolment form
- a completed Medical Records Transfer Request

AND proof of your eligibility and entitlement to enrol:

- a birth certificate or NZ passport if you were born in NZ

OR

- a passport with a NZ resident visa or permanent resident visa

When you enrol with Cambridge Family Health you are choosing us to be your preferred provider of general practice services.

This means we will hold the funding for your primary health care, reducing your consultation fee by the amount of subsidy we receive on your behalf from the Ministry of Health.

You may only be enrolled with one practice at any time.

If you are unsure whether you are enrolled at another practice - freephone 0800 458 448 to request the information.

**We are always available to talk with you if you would like further information or have any questions regarding enrolment.**

You are fully eligible and entitled to be enrolled if you are residing in New Zealand and:

- a) are a New Zealand citizen OR
- b) hold a resident visa or a permanent resident visa (or a residence permit if issued before December 2010) OR
- c) are an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident AND have been in New Zealand or intend to stay in New Zealand for at least 2 consecutive years OR
- d) have a work visa/permit and are able to show that you are able to be in New Zealand for at least 2 years (previous permits included) OR
- e) are an interim visa holder who was eligible immediately before their interim visa started OR
- f) are a refugee or protected person OR are in the process of applying for, or appealing refugee or protection status, OR is a victim or suspected victim of people trafficking OR
- g) are under 18 years and in the care and control of a parent/legal guardian/adopting parent who meets one criterion in clauses a–f above OR
- h) are 18 or 19 years old and can demonstrate that, on 15 April 2011, you were the dependant of an eligible work visa/permit holder (visa must still be valid) OR
- i) are a NZ Aid Programme student studying in New Zealand and receiving Official Development Assistance funding (or their partner or child under 18 years old) OR
- j) are participating in the Ministry of Education Foreign Language Teaching Assistantship scheme OR
- k) are a Commonwealth Scholarship holder studying in New Zealand and receiving funding from a New Zealand university under the Commonwealth Scholarship and Fellowship Fund.
